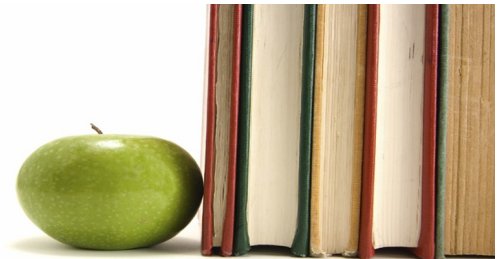

Literacy—Reading

Your child being a good reader starts with you! It's never too late...

1. Read together every day.
2. Read it again and again if that's what your child wants—reinforcement and repetition helps your child learn!
3. Read with expression—do the voices and vary your tone and speed.
4. Discuss while you read—the characters, setting, what might happen next, etc.
5. Be a fan—build their confidence with praise and by being a good listener.
6. Make books special—make regular trips to the library and give books as gifts!

Numeracy Counting, Sorting, Patterning...EATING!

This Halloween use your candies to do some fun math at home! When you empty your trick or treat bag, count how many candies you have! Once you have counted your candies, sort them into groups.
