Reminder to All Curve Lake First Nation Citizens

Please keep in mind that when harvesting within Treaty 20 and/or Curve Lake First Nation (CLFN) lands, all Curve Lake First Nation Citizens are governed under the Interim Enforcement Policy. The IEP requires you to carry proper identification (status card) on you at all times that you are out harvesting, along with all of the required safety equipment (lifejackets, paddles, whistles, gun cases and/or locks, etc.) and applicable licenses (such as, but not limited to; Pleasure Craft Operators card if operating a boat or firearms license if utilizing a firearm) while out harvesting.

Copies of the Interim Enforcement Policy and Treaty 20 maps are available at the Government Services Building and online in the Curve Lake First Nation Member Login Portal at www.curvelakefirstnation.ca

Under the IEP, the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) are required to contact Curve Lake First Nation Chief if they are going to be on CLFN lands, they also are required to be accompanied by the Anishinabek Police Services (APS) Officer. If you encounter an MNR official without APS presence, please contact Chief Phyllis Williams at the Government Services Building, in person, by phone (705-657-8045) or via email at chief@curvelakefn.ca.

Keep in mind of our traditional ways and only harvest what you need!

Share your knowledge and experience with a CLFN citizens who may not have an opportunity to go harvesting, by taking them out to harvest with you or by sharing your harvest with them. Also consider sharing your harvest with any other citizens who may not be able to get out to harvest fish or wild game, such as Elders and families who do not harvest but enjoy eating our traditional foods.

Have a fun time practicing your rights to harvest but stay safe and always take a friend with you!
Please exercise your common sense when harvesting as well as no drinking and driving!
