



## Hydro One First Nations, Métis and Inuit (FNMI) Scholarships Application

Hydro One sponsors two annual awards for outstanding First Nation, Métis or Inuit students attending an Ontario college or university. In addition to a cash award, winners are given an opportunity to obtain a paid position performing developmental work with Hydro One.

### TO APPLY FOR A HYDRO ONE FNMI SCHOLARSHIP

#### **Value of Award:**

- Two annual academic awards, in the amount of: \$5000 university or \$3000 college
- Offer of a developmental work term with Hydro One Networks.

#### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- First Nations/Métis/Inuit students in good academic standing currently in their **first, second, or third** year of Electrical, Mechanical, Civil or Engineering/Technology, Computer Science, Forestry, Business, Information Technology, Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science/Studies – or a combination of these programs.
- In good academic standing
- Demonstrated leadership skills and involvement in extra-curricular campus/community activities
- Demonstrated strength in oral and written communication skills
- No more than one other concurrent award of equal or greater value held in second year
- Applicants must be legally eligible to work in Canada upon graduation
- Proof of Aboriginal ancestry (ie. Status, Treaty, Métis Membership or Nunavut Certificate Card)
