



Recreation Incentive Application

The Curve Lake First Nation Recreation Committee is able to offer a reimbursement for the youth (18 years of age or younger) for any extra-curricular activities which are not funded by the Curve Lake First Nation Education or Health and Family Services programs. The maximum allowable for the reimbursement is 75% of the actual costs up to \$200.00 per child. This will allow the Recreation Committee to financially assist First Nation families this year. To claim reimbursement, return the completed application form along with receipts for the activity to the Administration Office. Activities could include hockey, baseball, soccer, gymnastics, any recreational activity or sport. The Recreation Committee will be reviewing the applications the last Wednesday of the month and will accept receipts that are dated between April 1 and March 31 of the current fiscal year or until all of the funds are exhausted.
