WHAT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT?

Read the Post Secondary Policy online at www.curvelakefirstnation.ca or request one from the Curve Lake First Nation Education Department.

It is your responsibility to maintain a 60% average for each semester.

It is your responsibility to send CLFN Education your marks as soon as possible so you can continue to be funded.

If you are having difficulty in one of your courses get help as soon as possible.

Current contact information is **mandatory**.

WHAT THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT NEEDS FROM YOU?

An application form that is completely filled out by you and handed in before the **deadline dates**:

- January Intake - **September 30**
- April Intake - **January 31**
- September Intake - **May 31**

HOW DO I KNOW IF I GET FUNDED?

Once the applications have been reviewed a week after deadline dates a letter will be sent to you stating whether or not you will be funded by CLFN Education Department.

If you are funded, you receive a package consisting of:

- A letter stating you have been funded
- Student Information Form
- Student Mark Release Form
- Release of Information Form
- Direct Deposit Form

Please complete forms provided in package along with a copy of your acceptance letter from the institution you will be attending, to the Education Department.

WHAT WILL CLFN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PAY FOR?

You will receive a monthly living allowance. For an academic school year post-secondary single students receive \$800.00 monthly x 8 months = \$6400.00

If you choose to live in residence you will use the living allowance to pay for the residence fees.

If the fees are over \$6400.00 it is your responsibility to pay the balance.

There is book allowance of \$400.00 per semester. In order to receive \$400.00 for the next semester you must submit receipts showing you spent your \$400.00 from the last semester.

We will pay tuition fees minus the Student Health Plan. It is your responsibility to opt out of the Health Plan or if you wish pay for it yourself.

HOW DO I OPT OUT OF THE HEALTH PLAN?

You have to go to the Students Accounts Office and let them know you are opting out of the Student Health Plan.

Some institutions require you to sign a form others request a letter from the Health Centre saying you are already covered.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE MY LIVING ALLOWANCE AND BOOK ALLOWANCE?

Your book and living allowance will be deposited into your account at the end of August. Then your next cheque will be deposited at the end of September etc.

If you are planning to live in residence the full amount, along with book allowance will be mailed to you around the second week of August.

HOW IS THE TUITION PAID?

A sponsor letter is sent to the institution you will be attending and they will invoice CLFN Education Department. Once CLFN Education Department receive invoice we will pay for it, as quickly as possible.
